Summer Feiseanna Planning - Important Info

In addition to the feiseanna this weekend, other local or nearby feis opportunities include:

- Northern Mid-America Championship Feis / 10,000 Lakes Feis June 15 & 16 quickfeis.com
 - Register on QuickFeis If you haven't registered with QuickFeis before, you'll have to create family and dancer profiles. Please note, if you've previously been on a team or competed at Oireachtas, you will have an account already since the MidAmerica Region Oireachtas uses QuickFeis..
 - Nationals Ceili Teams are **required** to perform in teams at the 10,000 Lakes Feis on Sunday ONLY. Solo competition at the June Feiseanna is at your own discretion.
 - These feiseanna are hosted by the Mulhern school.
 - Cormac and Natalie will only be there for First Feis and teams. It is the same weekend as an annual CIM event at the Celtic Junction. Other teachers will be there to help!
 - Please note, Saturday's feis includes a "Second Chance." Dancers may enroll in the Second Chance to dance again that afternoon. It's basically a double feis in one day! See attached for more information.
