IMDA's Decade of Dance Awards Deadline

The Irish Music and Dance Association will again present their Decade of Dance Awards to eligible dancers at IMDA's Day of Irish Dance at Landmark Center, St. Paul on Sunday, March 15, 2020. The award is presented to dancers who have studied Irish dance for at least ten years. For the 2019 presentations, the dancer would have begun their study by the Fall of 2009 or before and studied continuously. **Eligible dancers must complete an application for the award documenting their 10-year study of Irish dance. The deadline for applications is Dec 2, 2019 but you'll need to get it done and signed before OID is closed for break on 11/27.** Dancers will receive a confirmation by Feb 1, 2020.
