To keep the time organized and COVID-safe, we cannot accept drop-offs on the day of the exchange.

Sellers, before you drop off your solo costume for sale, please print your name, phone number, photo of the costume, and price and attach to the costume in a plastic sleeve. REMINDER: O'Shea is not responsible for the selling, buying or pricing. All transactions are solely between seller and buyer. Solo costumes will be available for pick up after the exchange on Thursday, 10/29 from 8pm to 9pm in the lobby or on Friday, 10/30 between 4 pm and 6 pm. All unsold costumes need to be picked up.
